



Graduation / Transfer Out and Retention Rates

Pursuant to the Student Right-to-Know Act, VGI determines and makes available each year the Graduation Rate and Transfer Out Rates of certificate or degree-seeking, first-time, full-time, undergraduate students. It is important to note that the Student Right-to-Know graduation rate is calculated at the school level.

The student Right-to-Know graduation rates and Transfer Out Rates are also available on the U.S. Department of Education's *College Navigator* website, located at <http://nces.ed.gov/collegenavigator/>. Information regarding the graduation rates disaggregated by gender, major racial and ethnic subgroup (as defined in IPEDS), recipients of a federal Pell Grant, recipients of a subsidized Stafford Loan who did not receive a Pell Grant and students who did not receive either a Pell Grant or subsidized Stafford Loan can also be obtained at the administration building.

VGI's Retention rates, including the retention rate of certificate or degree seeking, first-time, undergraduate students as reported to IPEDS, are available at the Administration Building and a written copy will be provided to any student upon request prior to the student's enrolling or entering into any financial obligation with the school. In addition, students enrolling at VGI are given the school's graduation rate, transfer out rates and retention rates as reported by its state licensing agency, Texas Workforce Commission prior to officially registering for their program of study.
